- 1 This park is known for two stunning waterfalls.
- 3 This park holds a reservoir which served as a water supply for the City of Oberlin until the early 1900s.
- 5 This reservation features an over 21 acre reservoir.
- 7 This park features three individual creeks.
- 9 This park has a field dedicated to RC airplanes.
- 14 This park is known as the skinniest park in the Lorain County Metro Parks system.
- 17 This rec center holds a 2-story, indoor water slide.
- 18 This park offers spectacular lake front views of the Lorain Lighthouse.
- 19 This park is the district's largest at 1,917 acres.

Down

- 2 This rec center offers an indoor walking track.
- 3 The creation of this reservation started with the "Save the Woods" organization.
- 4 This park offers visitors an 18-hole mini golf course.
- 6 This reservation holds the districts first park location.
- 8 This reservation showcases a trail which includes a 1000-foot bridge that crosses the river in two places.
- 10 This reservation features an inclusive playground.
- 11 The highlight of this park is the 5,000 sq. foot Conservatory, the first in Lorain County.
- 12 This park was the first joint effort between a city and a metro park in the state of Ohio.
- 13 This park is one of the most popular sites for birding in Lorain County.
- 15 This park is actually located in Erie County, but was donated to LCMP.
- 16 This preserve holds a barn that dates back to the 1800s and was named after a freed slave.
