DESIGNS in NATURE - find these shapes or designs to capture.

1. Animal shape in the clouds
2. Colored stripes in a rock
3. Face in the clouds
4. Zig-zag edges on a leaf
5. A triangle shaped leaf
6. Pine cone scales
7. A heart-shaped leaf
8. Something round
9. Three leaf clover
10. A design or shape not listed



COLORS of the RAINBOW - gather together several photos of each listed item.

1. Red
2. Indigo (dark purplish-blue)
3. Orange
4. Violet (purple)
5. Yellow
6. Blue
7. Green
8. Picture of rain
9. Shadow (the sun is out)
10. Picture of scenery



Listed above are all of the colors of the visible light spectrum that are produced when it rains AND there is sun. This allows for the reflection of these colors, producing the rainbow. Create a rainbow with the printed-out pictures of each color (rainbow order – red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, violet), and add to your photo journal!
